

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### My Dear Parishioners:

It seems that with the "whirlwind" of the past Holidays we have gotten a litte behind in our reporting to you -- so let's get started right, this second Sunday of 1972.

CHRISTMAS COLLECTION

The Total amount for the Christmas Collection came to \$8,683.67 here at Saint John's. We are most grateful to those of our Parishioners who heeded our request to try and increase their Christmas Contribution, and give at least \$5.00.

Because of this, our Christmas Collection this year, exceeded last year's by nearly \$1,200.00. Thank you!

OFFERTORY ENVELOPE REPORT

The Offertory Envelope income from Sunday, December 26th, 1971 came to \$1,892.05. We missed our Budget Figure by \$207.95. On January 1st, 1972, the Feast of the Solemnity of Mary, the offerings came to \$1,955.99. Here we only missed the Budget Figure by \$144.01. Last Sunday, the amount came to \$1,866.79 and the Budget Deficit came to \$233.21.

As of this Sunday, our Budget Deficit stands at a huge amount - \$11,605.80. It is our sincerest hope that we will be able to wipe out the Deficit in the months to come. The only way that this can be done, is be continued co-operation of ALL of our parishioners, in 1972, as in the past!

SCHOOL SUPPORT COLLECTION

The December School Support Collection amounted to \$791.92. We have continually repeated that this "Special" Collection for the Support of the Parish School will determine if Tuition will be raised. If this Collection does not reach \$2,000.00 a month, we will have no recourse, except to raise Tuition in September!

#### MONTHLY ENVELOPE MAILING

We are happy to report that MOST of those parishioners who received the packets of Monthly Offering Envelopes did use them on January 1st, and 2nd. Many in fact, saw fit to help defray the cost of these envelopes by using the Initial Offering Envelope. We hope that ALL who received envelopes will use them this year! As was stated previously, a Report of Offerings will be mailed each Quarter to all of our parishioners.

On Page 6 of this week's Bulletin is the list of the \$2.00 A Sunday and Holy Day Offerings. If your name is not on this listing, it means that you did not give at least \$2.00 for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and the 4 Sundays during the month of December. If your envelopes are for Mr. and Mrs. or a Family, you must contribute at leat \$4.00 a Sunday and Holy Day for your name to be on this list!

Due to the mix up of the mails at Christmas Time, some of our parishioners did not receive their Monthly Envelopes. If this is the case with you, please notify the Rectory, either in person or by phone, to make sure that the Envelope Company did not make a mistake and perhaps ommitted your name, or have your address listed incorretly. Thank You!
