
Many, many things to say this day, so we had better get started!

SUNDAY OFFERTORY ENVELOPE REPORT

On Sunday, March 19th, the Offertory Envelope Collection came to \$1,956.99 -- \$13.72 MORE than the previous Sunday, with 1189 Envelopes used. We missed our Budget Figure by only \$143.01, so that our Budget Deficit now stands at -- \$14,214.27.

BUT -- on last Sunday, March 26th, our Offertory Collection amounted to -- \$2,150.90 -- \$50.90 OVER our Budget Figure and \$193.91 MORE than on March 19th. 1221 Offertory Envelopes were used. This REDUCES our Budget Deficit so that as of this date it stands at -- \$14,163.37.

This tremendous effort on YOUR part, shows to me once again, that we can reach \$2,100.00 each Sunday and Holy Day! Many, many Thanks!



FLOWER COLLECTION

The Flower Collection of last Sunday, came to \$946.64 -- the largest Flower Collection ever! You see the fruits of your monies before you today -- at the beautifully decorated Altars. You still make it possible for St. John's to be the nicest Church around! What monies that were not used for these decorations will be put in the Parish General Fund for payment of regular Parish Expenses.

SCHOOL SUPPORT COLLECTION

The March total of the Special School Support Envelopes came to \$899.79. There were 485 envelopes used. Even tho Tuition is going up slightly, we will still need your support in this Special Monthly Collection for YOUR PARISH SCHOOL.

CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES COLLECTION

The amount contributed for the recent Archdiocesan Collection for the Catholic Relief Services came to \$673.53. "Thank You!" for these monies -- rest assured it will be put to good use by the CRS around the world, helping out the less fortunate.
