

"Take it and share."


Starving people! By heaven fed!

DO YOUR PART -

DO YOU care enough to support communities such as yours, so that they can remain a stabilized and viable part of this great CITY of OURS ???.

The only possible answer must be YES if you care about your community. Nobody should expect you to give up your pleasures; such as sports; T. V; movies or whatever; but you should devote some of your leisure time to support community organizations (such as CASA) that fight to keep it a good place to work in; to live in; to play in; and worship in.

CASA (census areas stabilization alliance) insists that the United States Congress correct the many injustices that the FHA has forced upon us and which has caused many of our fine communities to become "ghetto's".

OPPORTUNITY

YOU WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY to help yourself and your community by participating in CASA'S letter writing program to our congressmen. ----- CASA has met with both of our United States Senators, we presume that they do know our problems and expect them to support legislation to correct them --by using CASA'S (5) point program.

# SIGN THE LETTER

NEXT SUNDAY, CASA a city-wide coalition of civic, community, business and church organizations chartered in the State of Illinois as Census Areas Stabilization Alliance, an organization in which none of its officers are paid, --- will have their volunteers stationed at all entrances with letters addressed to our congressmen; for you to sign. ---- if for some reason you fail to take advantage of this opportunity; send your own letter as soon as possible.

THE FOLLOWING ARE THE FIVE (5) POINTS THAT CASA WANTS OUR CONGRESSMEN TO INTRODUCE INTO FUTURE HOUSING LEGISLATION.....

i- That the F.H.A. set up a program for monitoring mortgage loans, so that not more than 5% of the existing housing units in any census tract may be sold through FHA insured lending programs in any one year.

EXPLANATION --- The 5% limitation would not mean that 5% of the existing

EXPLANATION --- The 5% limitation would not mean that 5% of the existing housing in each community would change hands annually; nor would it mean that any incoming residents would be of any specific race or ethnic group.... it is entirely possible that not even 1% of the housing in a census tract may change ownership in any particular year..YOU and only YOU can decide this, by selling or staying put.

2- That FHA loans not be made available in racially peripheral communities (a one mile buffer zone) until they are available on a proportionate basis throughout the entire metropolitan area.

3- Because of inflation, the downpayment by the buyer thru FHA should be increased to ten (10) percent.

4- Eliminate the unjust point system imposed on the seller.

5- Make the mortgage loan firms share more responsibility in each sale.

#### DEAR CONGRESSMAN :

I, the undersigned; support the kind of program recommended by the Census Areas Stabilization Alliance (CASA) in their sincere effort to maintain the stability of our fine communities.

I do admit that from 1934 to 1968 that the F.H.A. had been very effective in providing adequate housing for those who needed it.

It is because of the failure of the United States Congress since 1968 as readily available statistics prove, to enact reasonable controls on the uses of F.H.A. mortgage loans that has resulted in serious financial losses to businesses and residential communities; and it threatens disaster for the FHA as well.

As a taxpayer, I feel that it is high time to bring about much needed changes, if not a complete overhaul of the FHA programs.

I URGE YOU AS MY CONGRESSMAN to give serious consideration to the following five (5) point program for enactment in any housing legislation that may come before you.

- 1- That F.H.A. set up a program for monitoring mortgage loans, so that not more than 5% of the existing housing units in any census tract may be sold through FHA insured lending programs in any one year.
- 2- That FHA loans not be made available in racially peripheral communities (a one mile buffer zone) until they are available on a proportionate basis throughout the entire metropolitan area.
- 3- Because of inflation, the downpayment by the buyer thru FHA should be increased to 10%.
- 4- Eliminate the unjust point system imposed on the seller.
- 5- Make the mortgage loan firm share more responsibility in each transaction.
